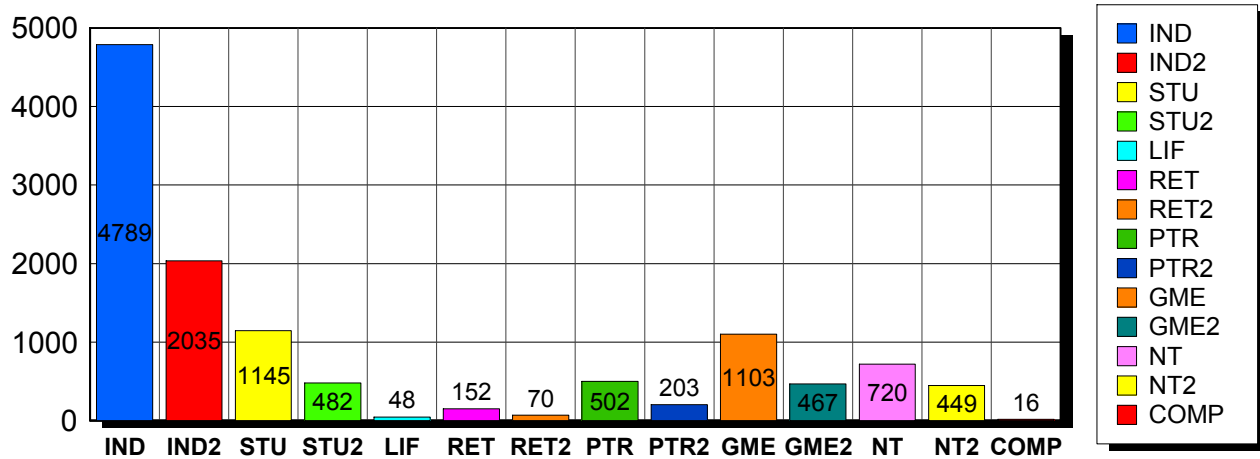

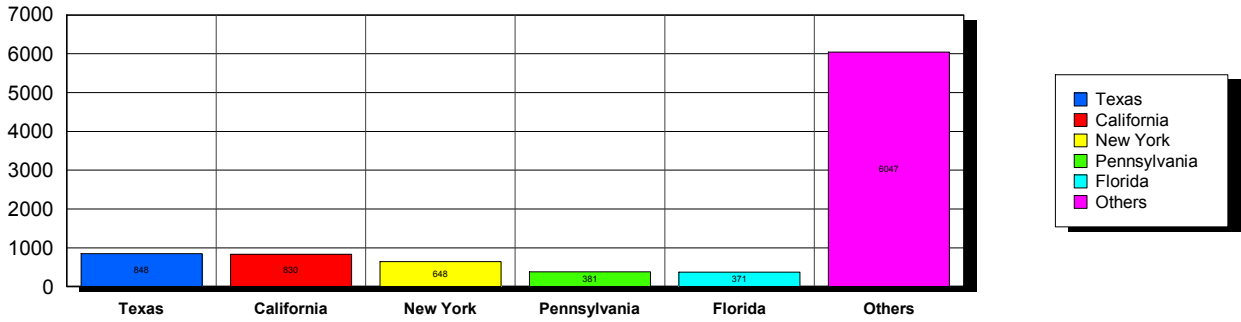

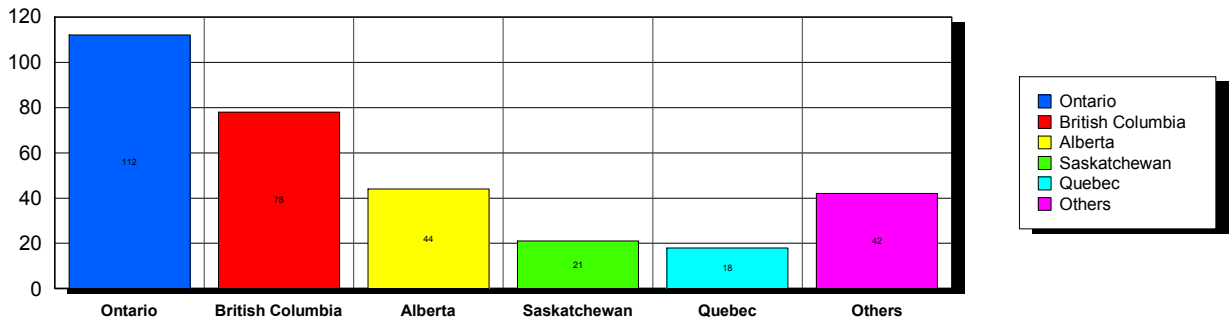

Top 5 States per Country

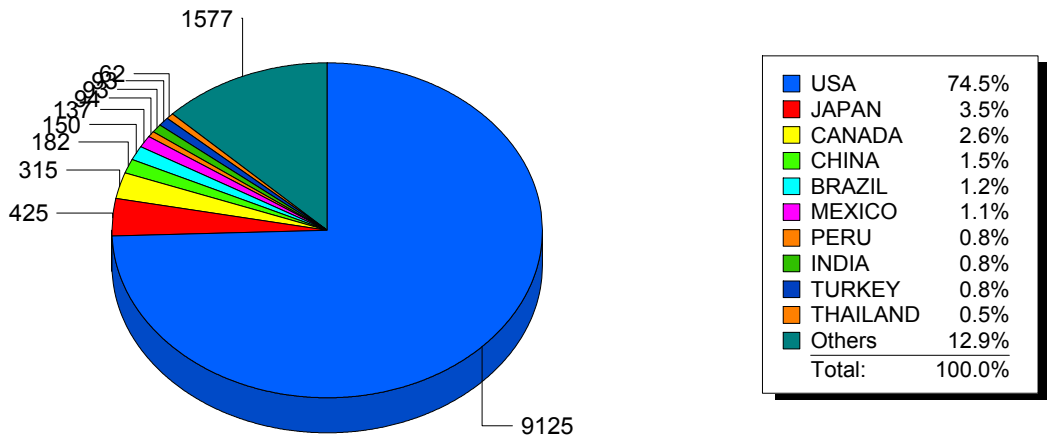


CANADA

Top 10 Countries



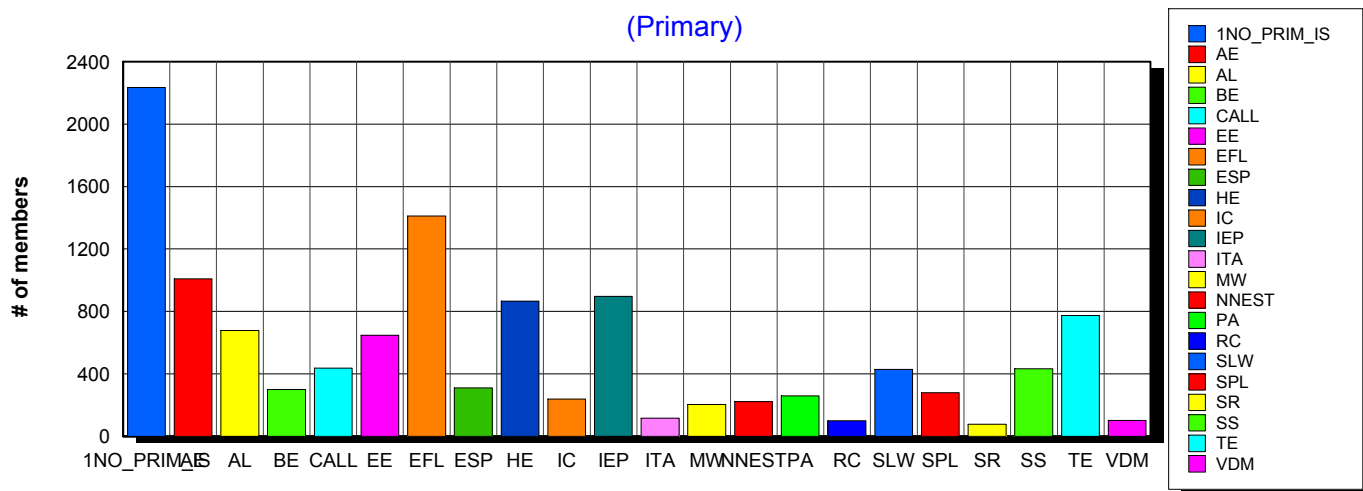

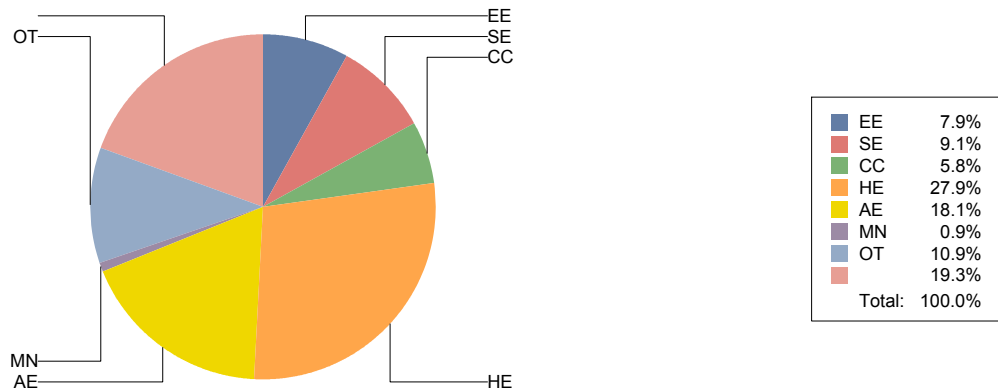
