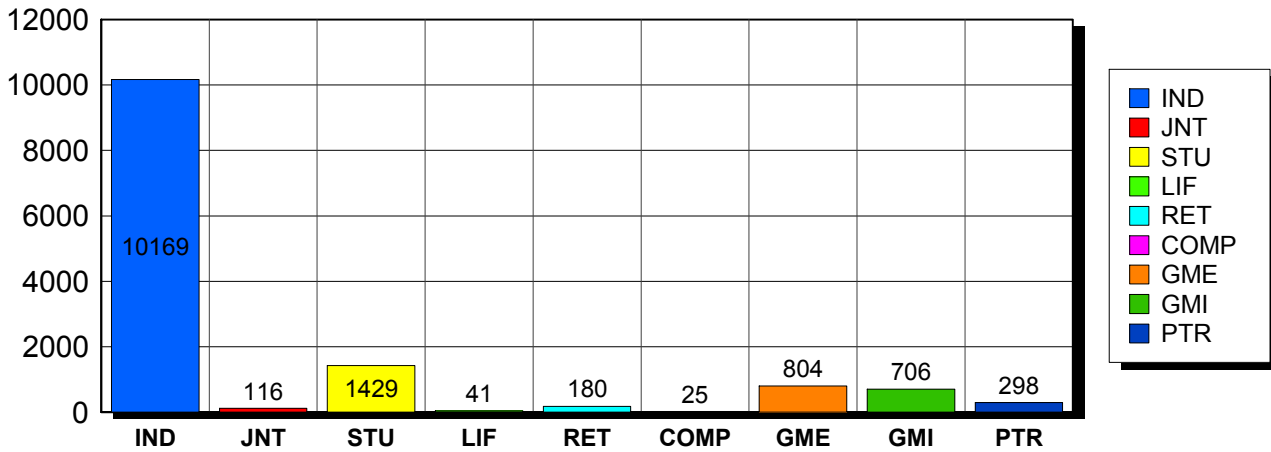

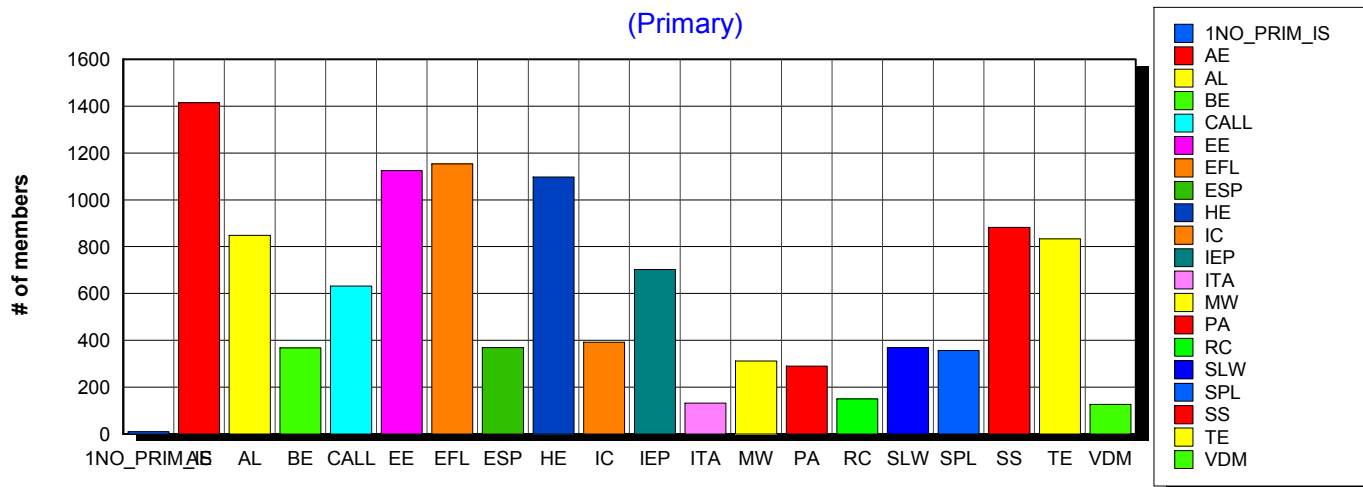

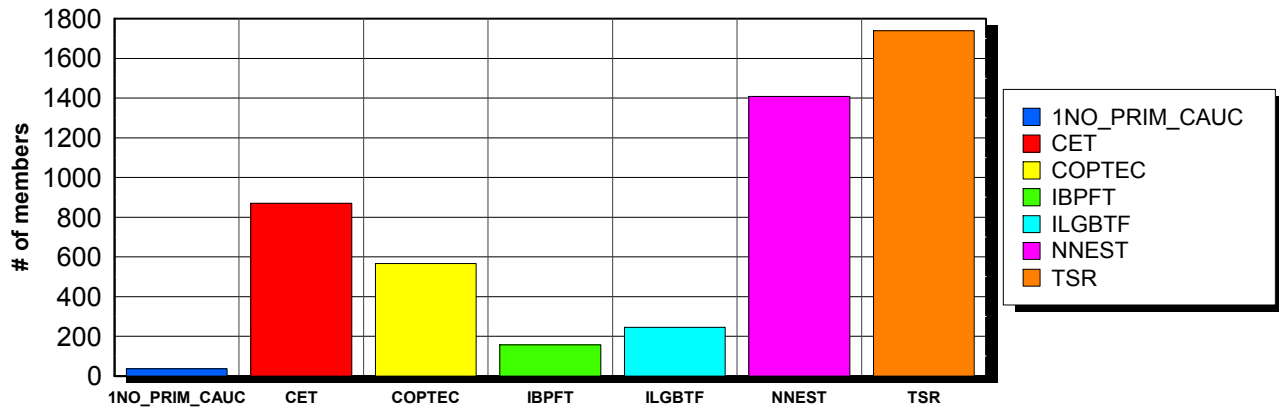

(Primary)

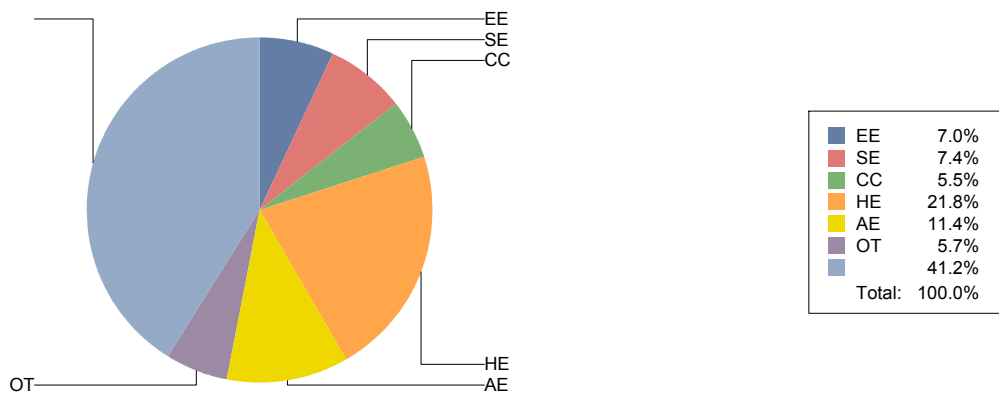

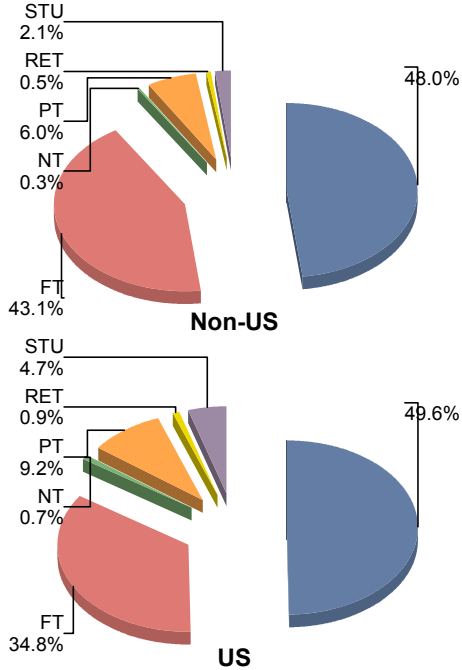
