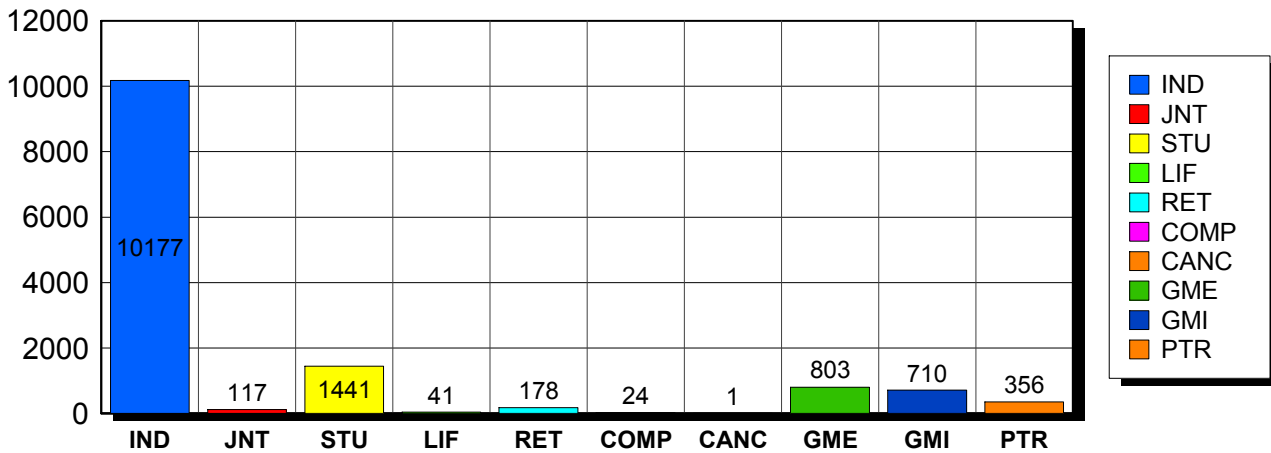

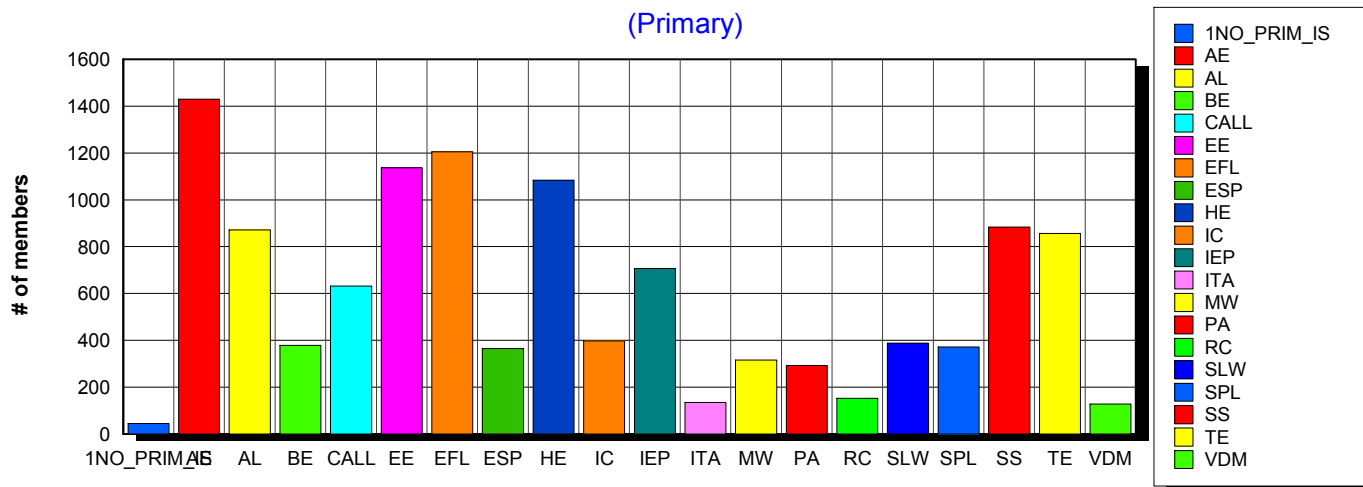

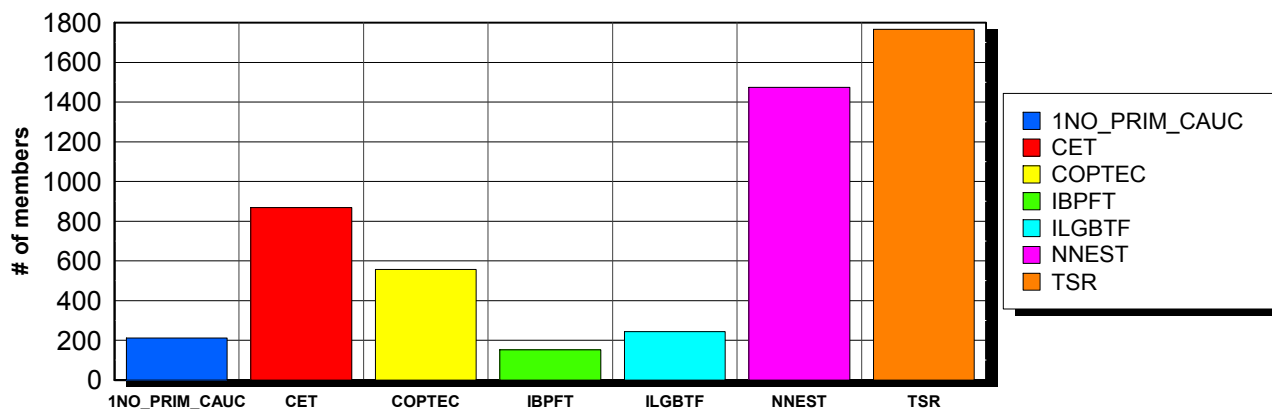

(Primary)

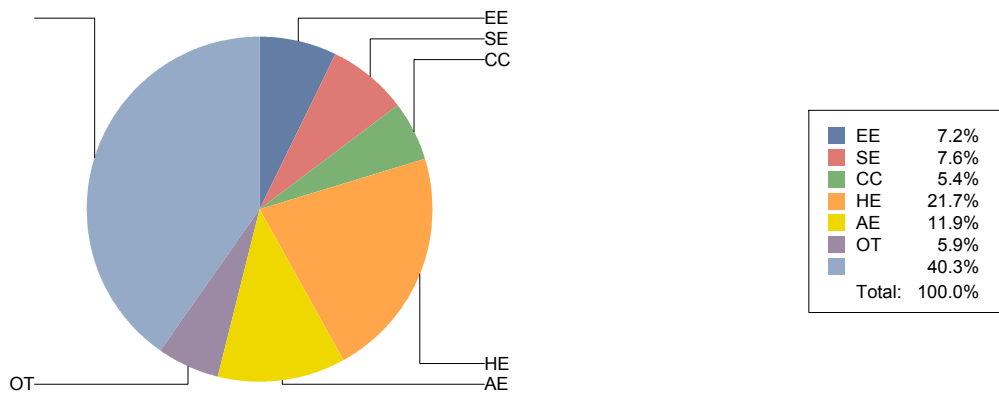
