

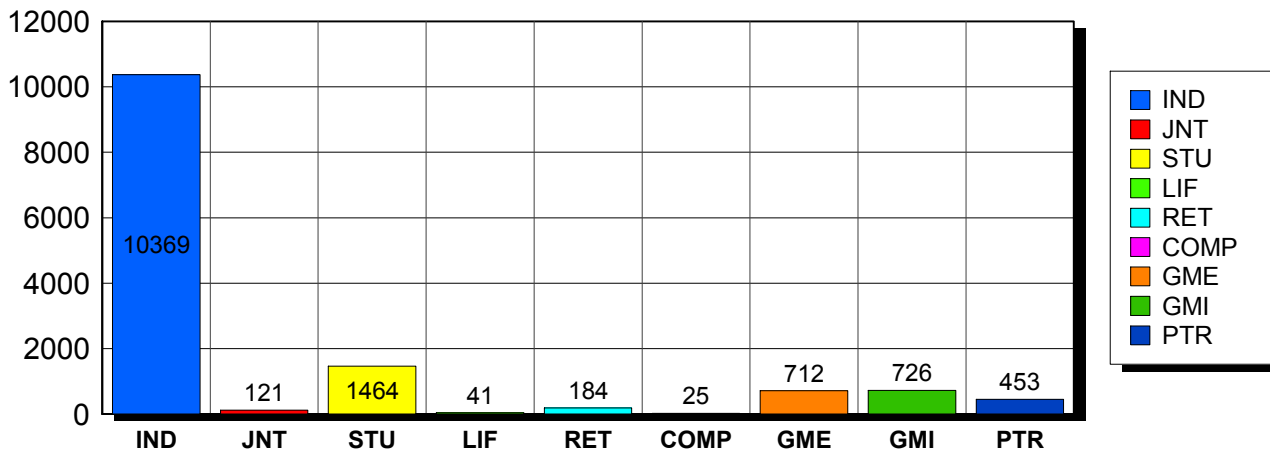

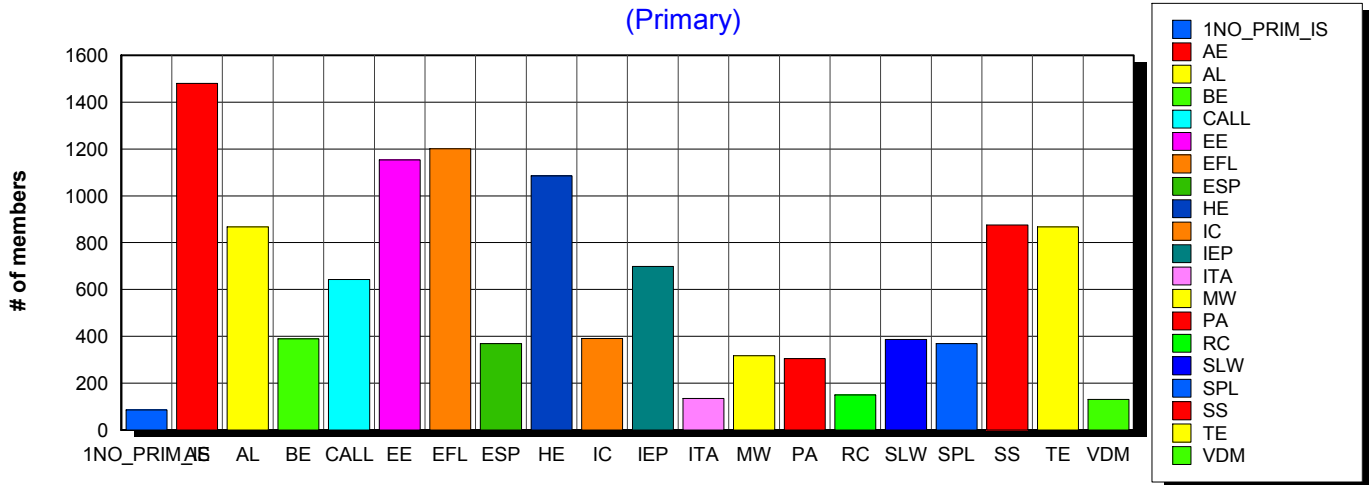

(Primary)



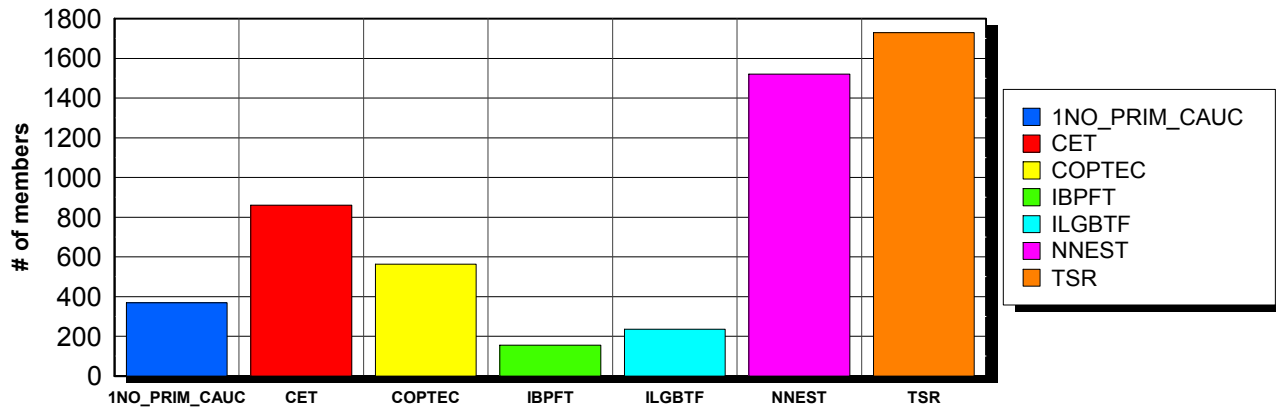

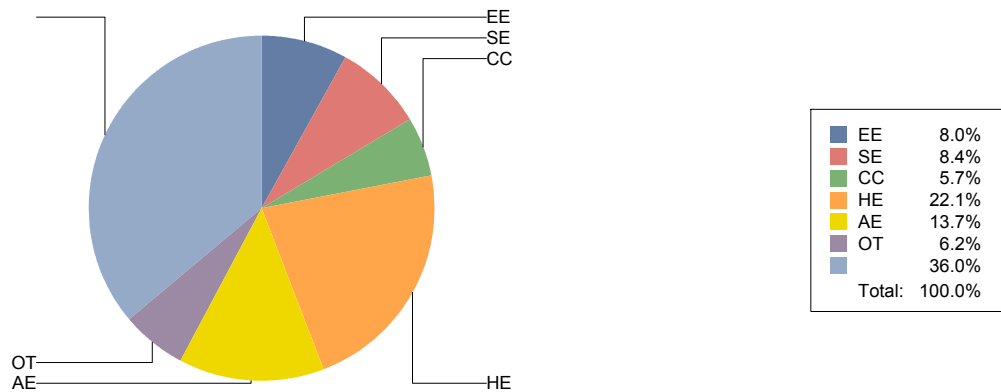
