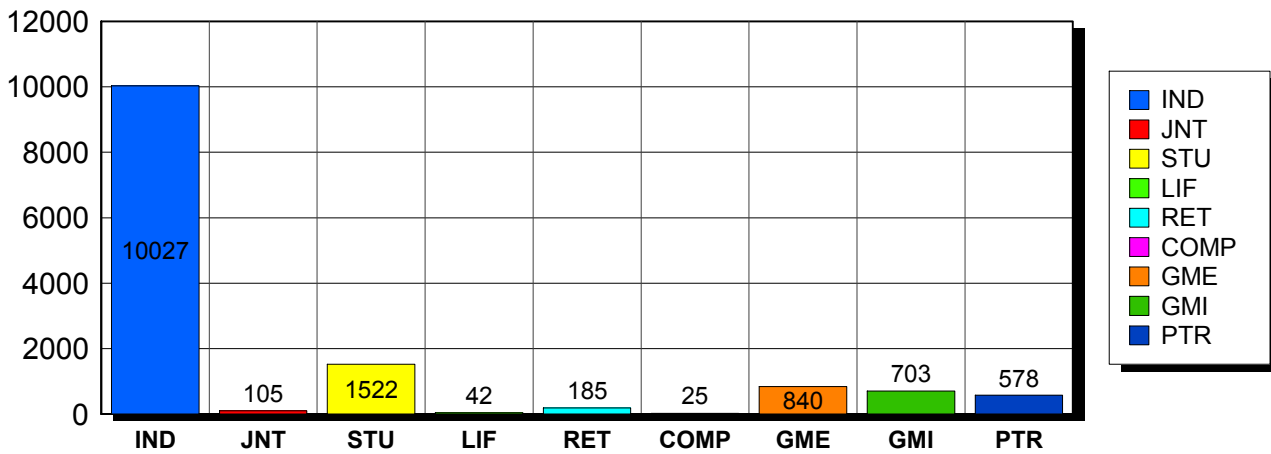

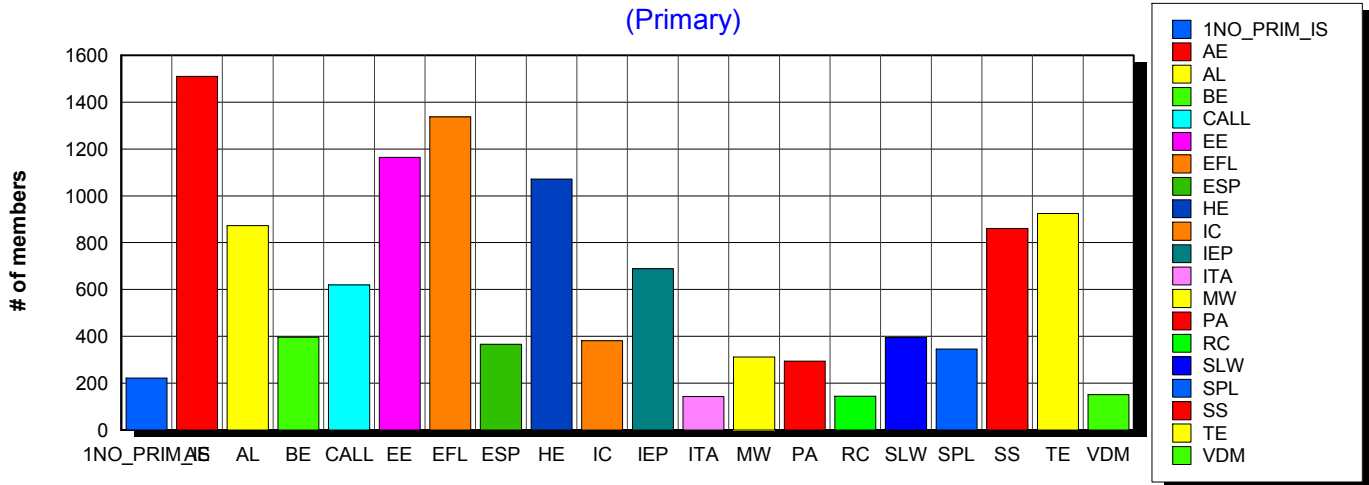

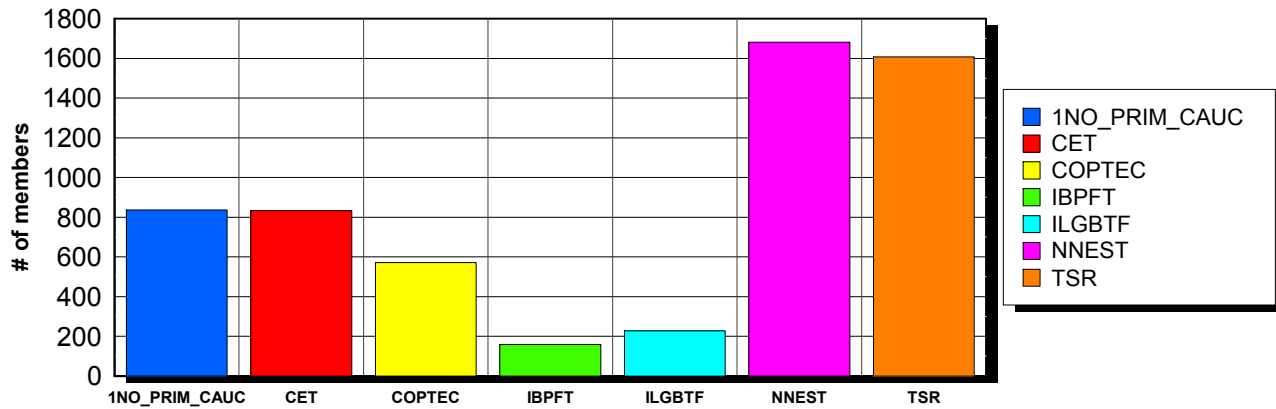

Caucuses (Primary)

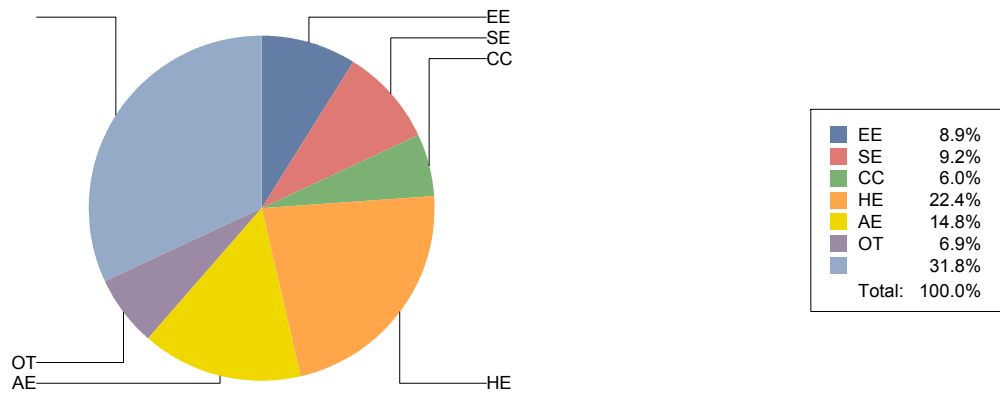
