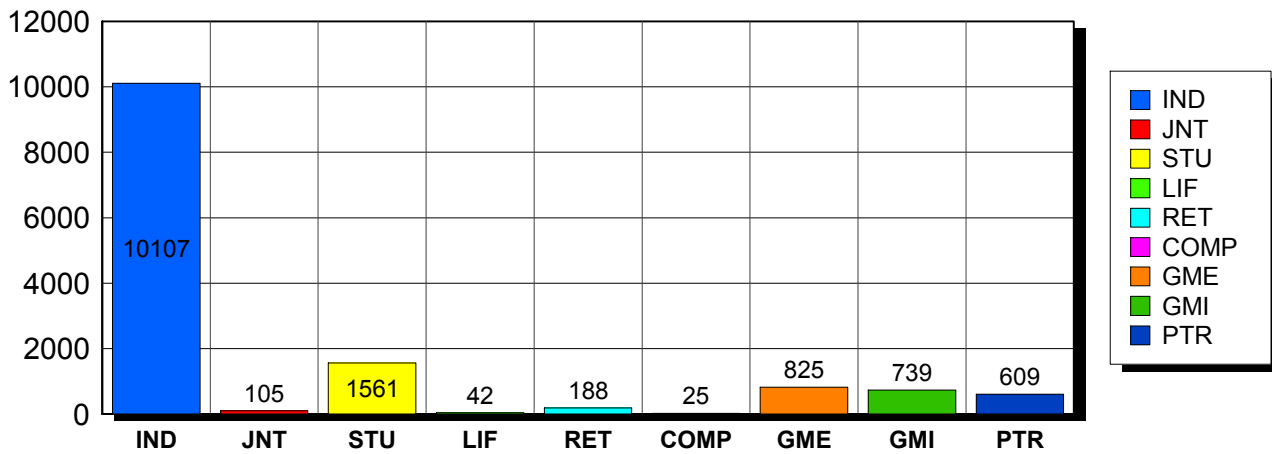

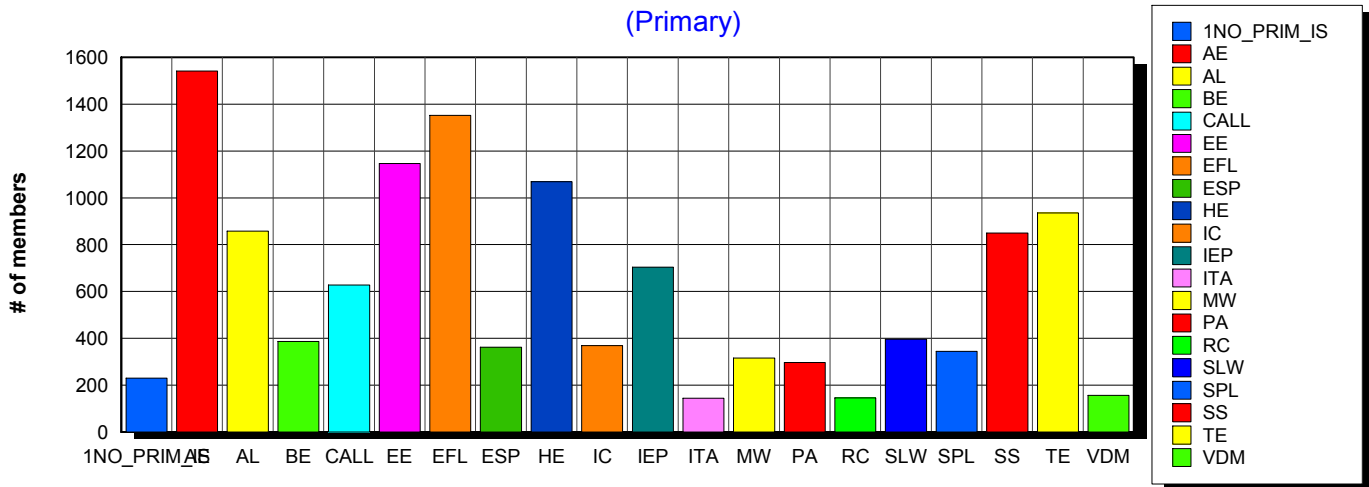

(Primary)



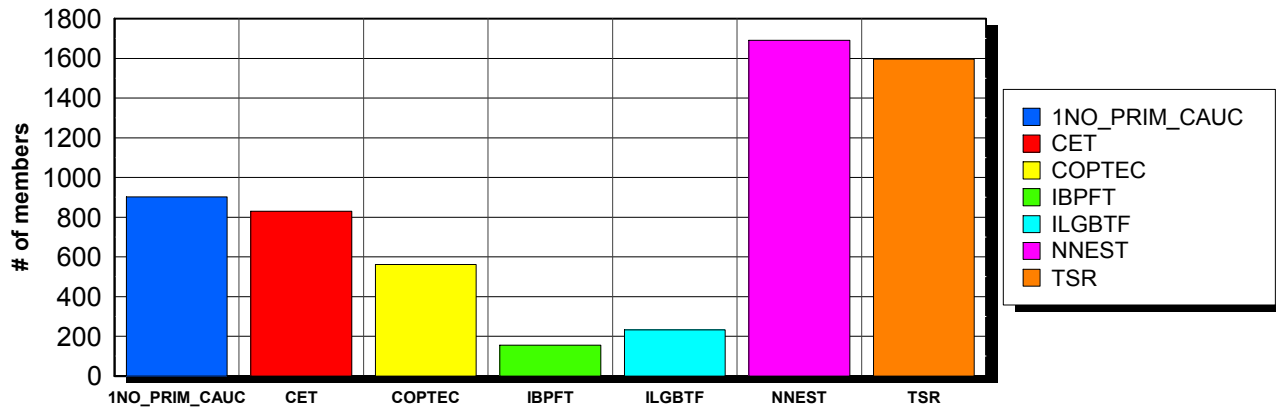

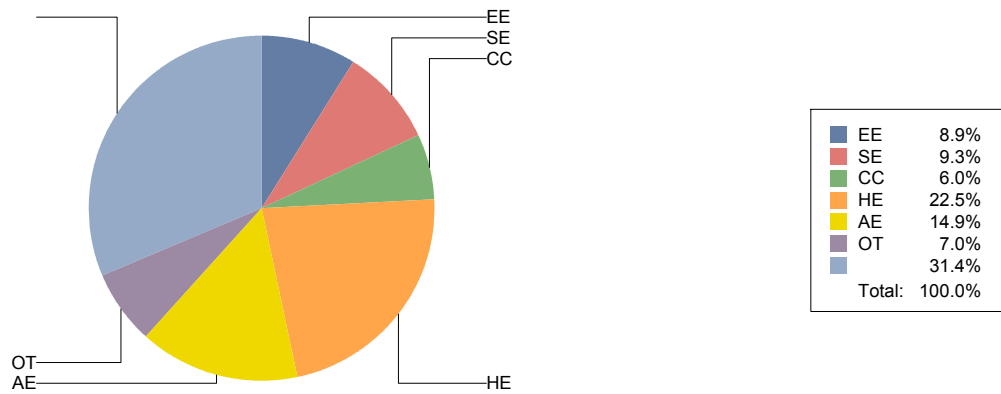
