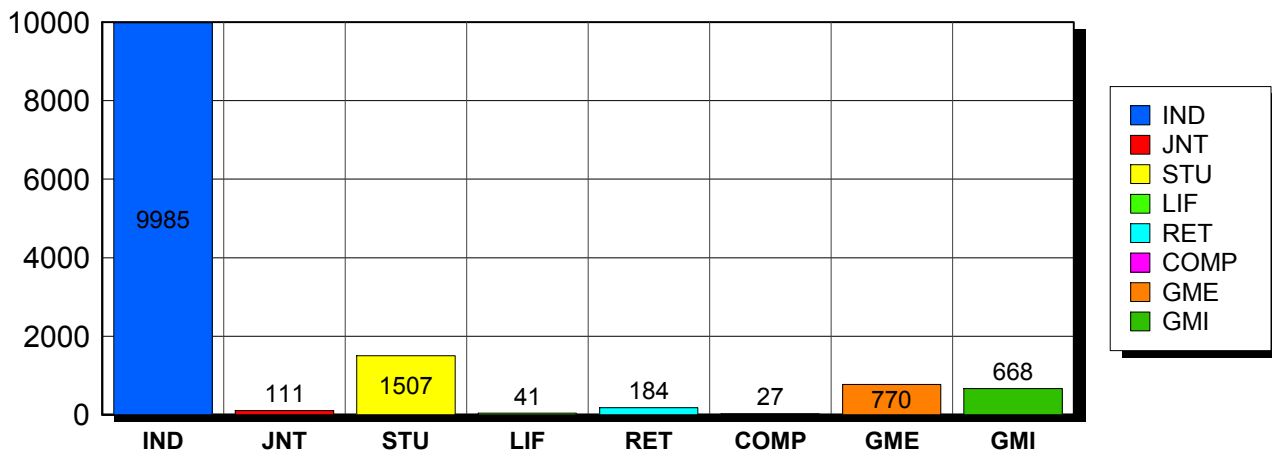

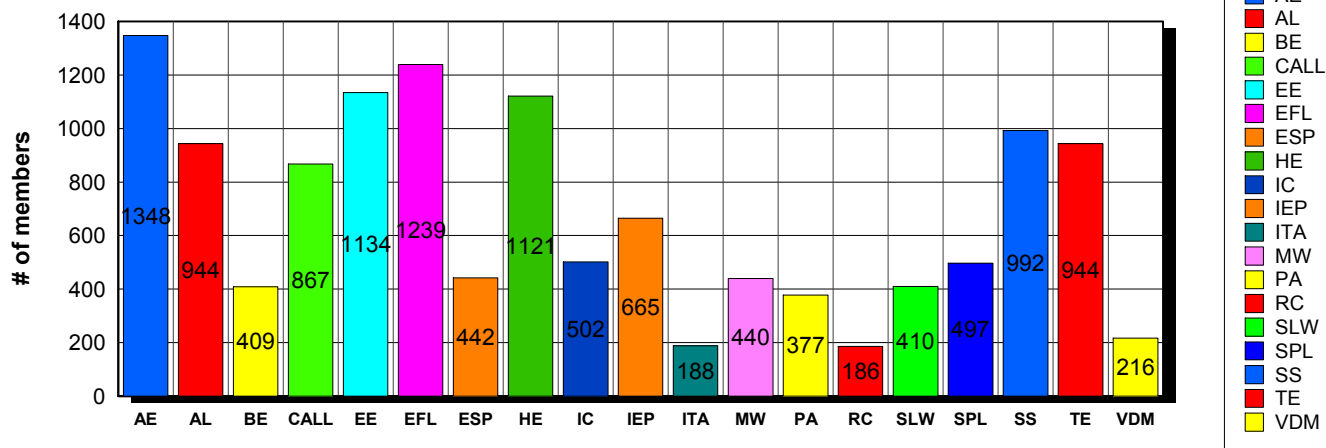

(Complimentary and paid combined)



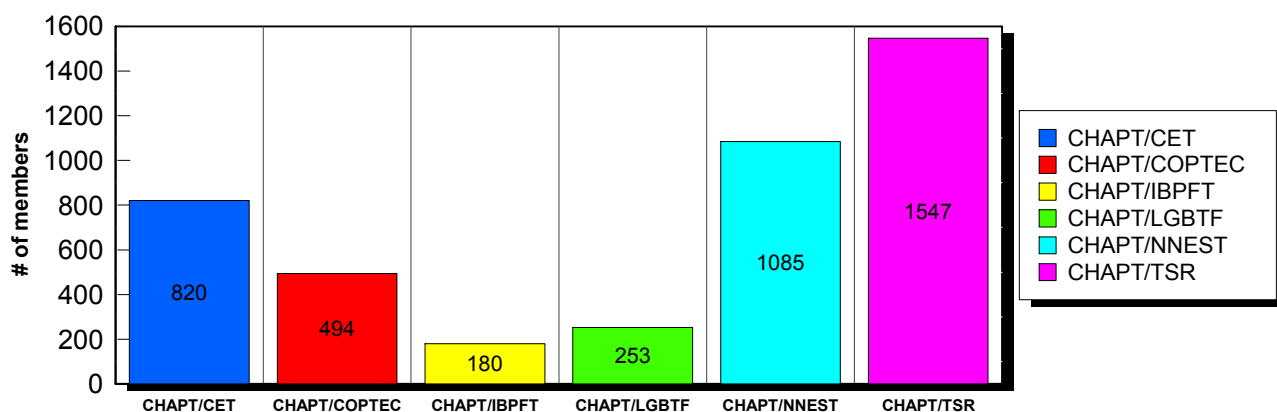

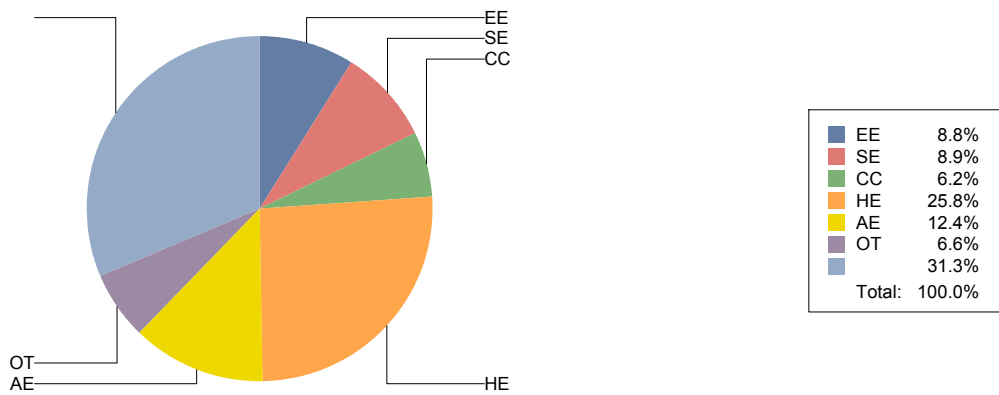

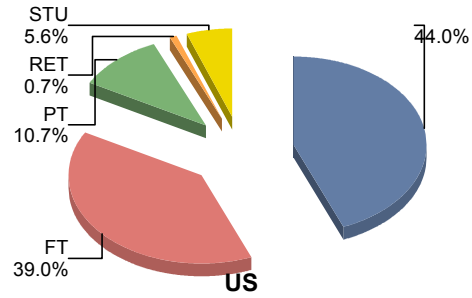
