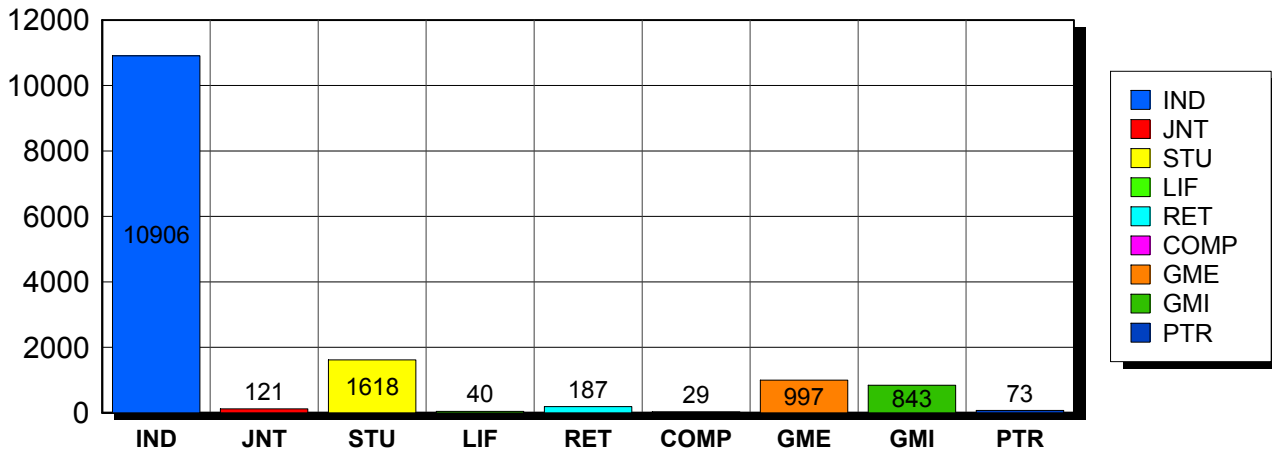

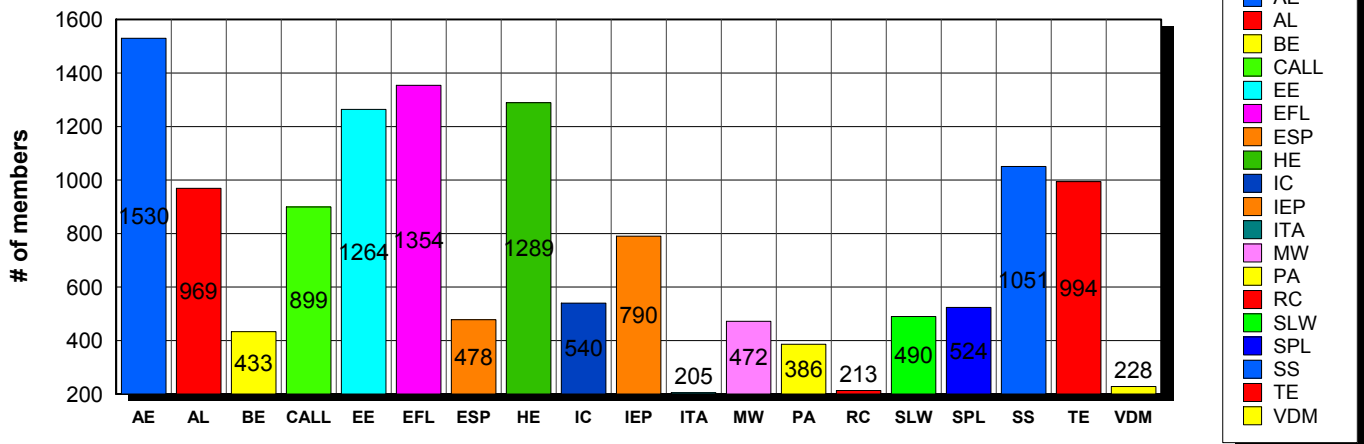

(Complimentary and paid combined)



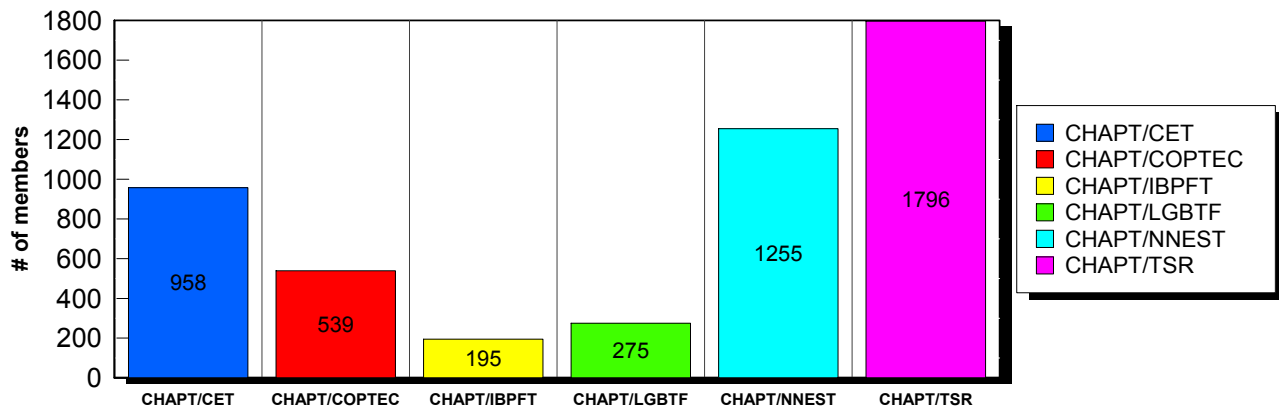

(Complimentary and paid combined)



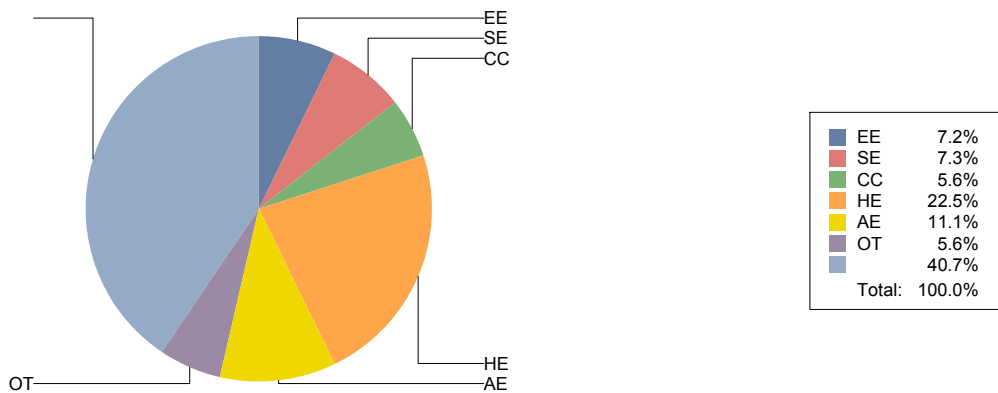

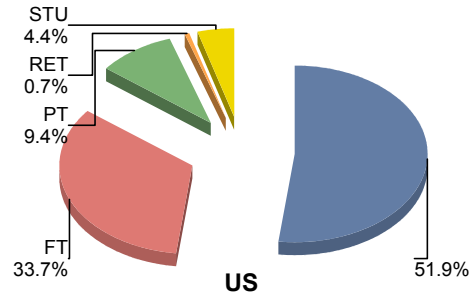
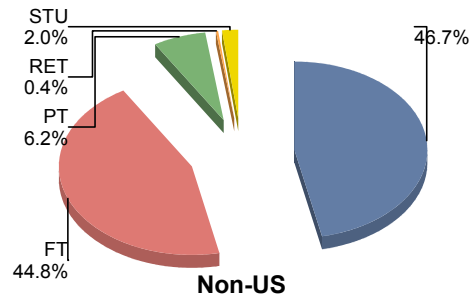
