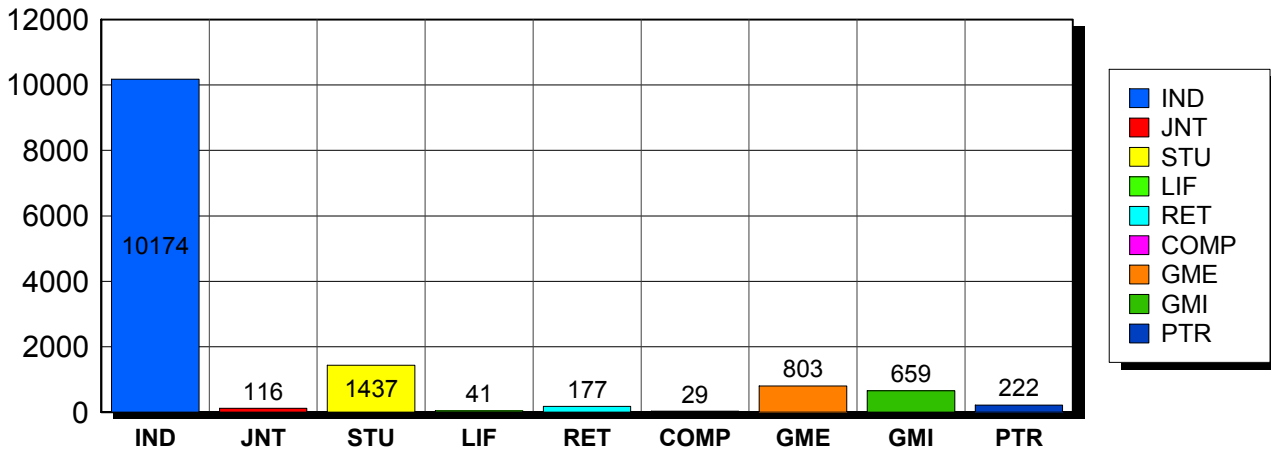

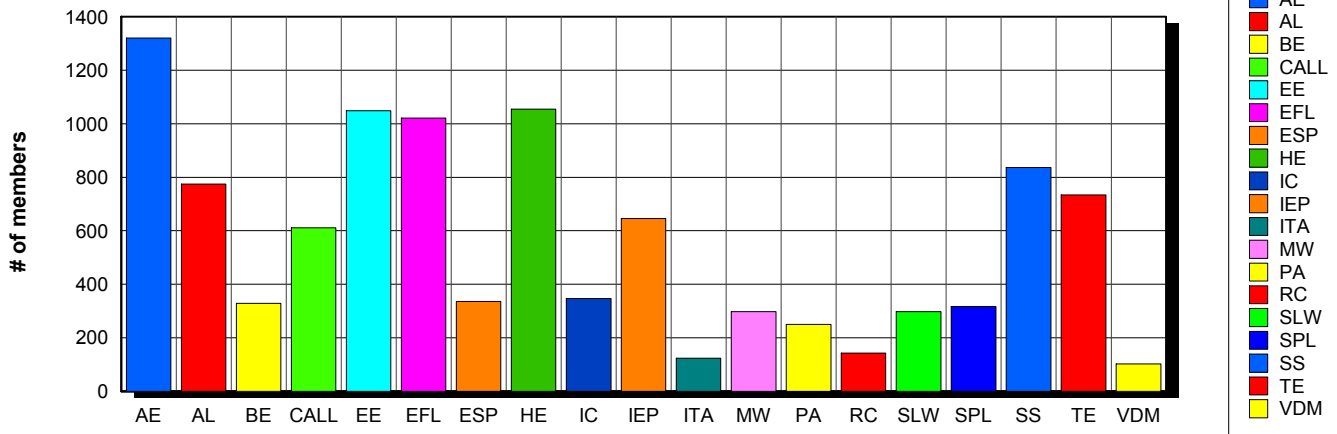

(Primary)



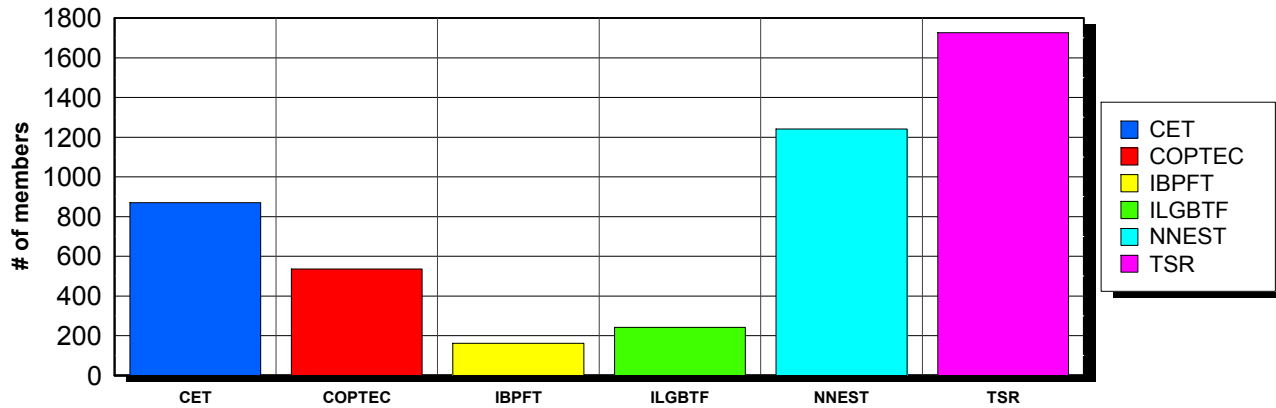

(Primary)

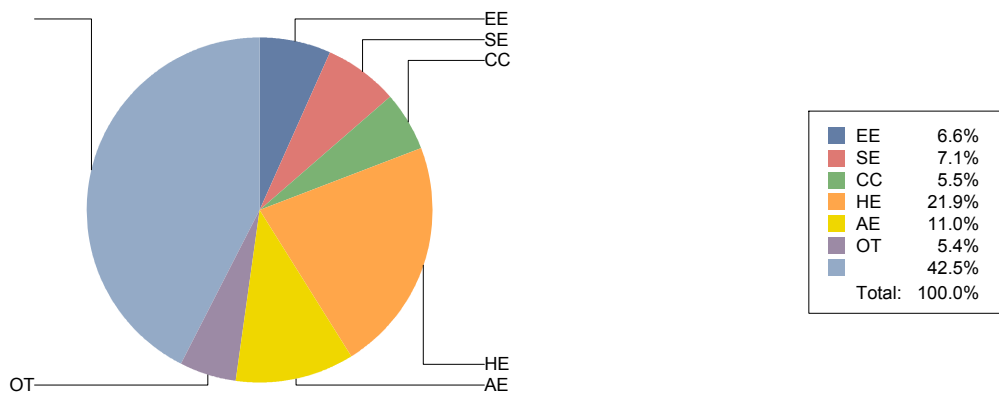

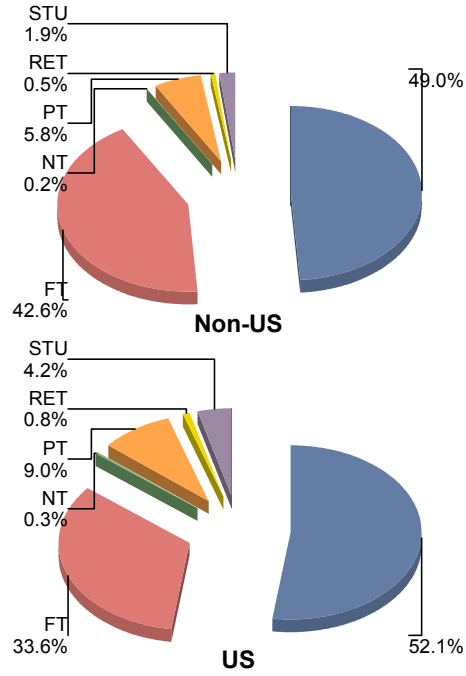
