

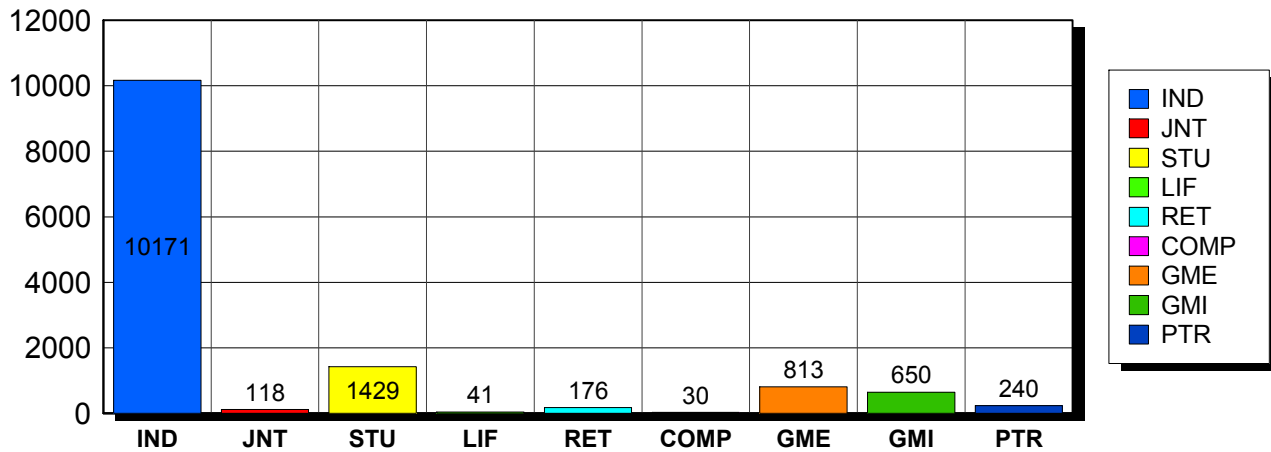

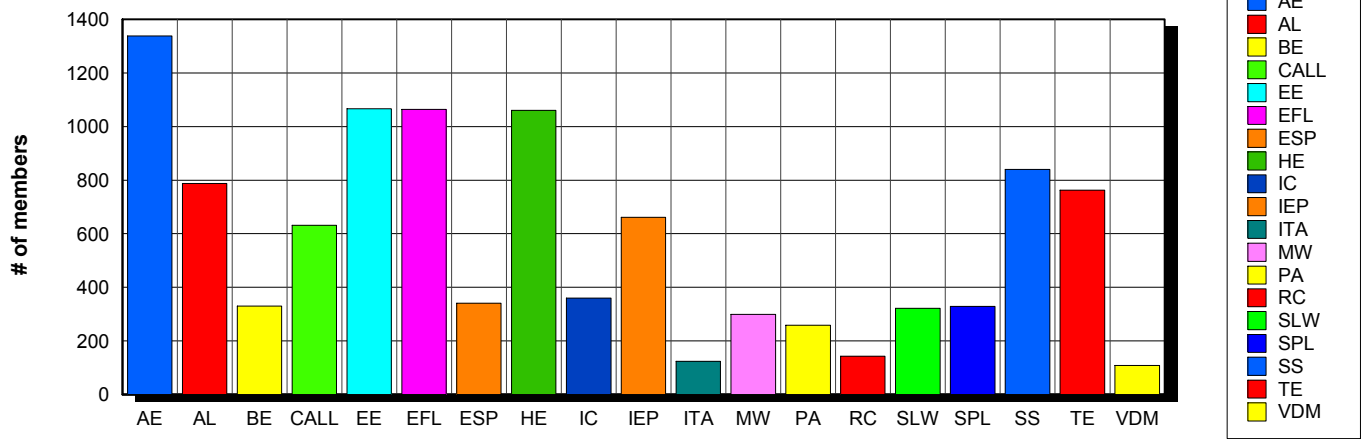

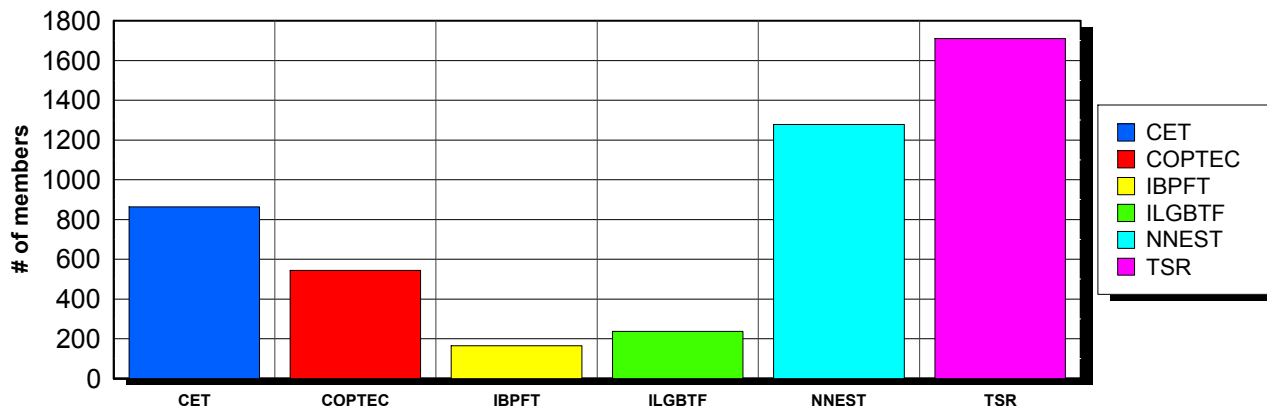

(Primary)

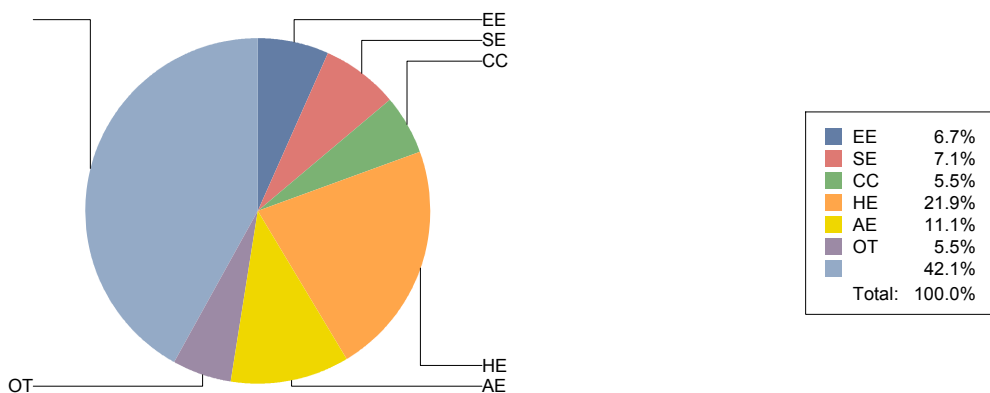

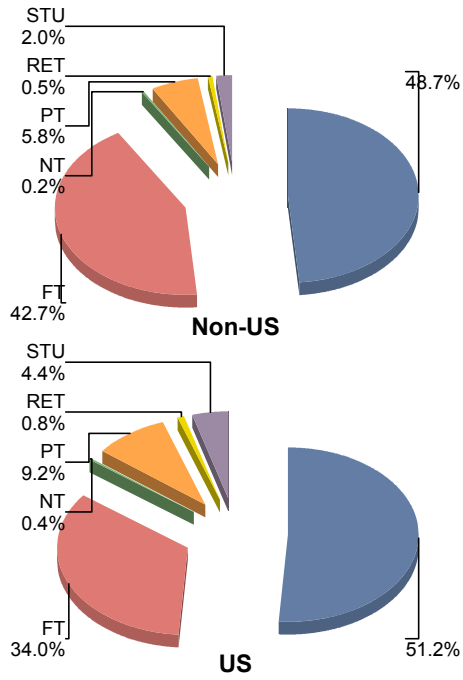
